Amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws effective 03/05/11  
These Amendments were introduced at the November 15<sup>th</sup> Association meeting

- 1- No member shall be penalized, or any action taken against that member, or have that members status changed from being a member in good standing, for working a track meet regardless of who or how that member was assigned the meet. This includes but not limited to if it was assigned by the assignor or assignors and if the Arbiter was used or not used.
- 2- Any votes on changes to the Constitution and/or By-Laws may only be voted on at the Chapter Annual Business Meeting as this is the most attended meeting.
- 3- The Assignor and the use of the Arbiter to assign Officials be an option for meet directors for a fee, but not be a mandated service or Required use for any organization that runs meets at a High School which belongs to the Shore Conference Schools or hosted by any High School that belongs to the Shore Conference Schools. This includes any Invitational, Sub-Varsity, and Novice meets.
- 4- That we adopt a change in the terminology as contained in Article 2, Sections 1 through 4 to adjust the position from Rules Interpreter to Rules Interpreter(s) and Assignor to Assignor(s) throughout all occurrences within.
