

## **Assignor Positions Defined & Chapter Procedures for Officials**

1. The Chapter will have two Assignors.
  - a. One assignor will assign ALL dual meets in both the fall, winter and spring seasons.
  - b. One assignor will assign ALL invitational and Championship meets in the fall, winter and spring seasons.
  
2.
  - a. The Chapter assignor for dual meets will be paid the fees that are assessed to each participating school in the fall and spring and a \$2,000.00 stipend paid from the Chapter treasury.
  - b. The Chapter assignor for invitational meets will be paid by an assessment of all meet organizers/directors of \$200/meet for meets in the spring and \$100/ meet for meets in the fall and winter and a \$1,000 stipend paid from the Chapter treasury.
  
3. All assignments for any High School meets run at or hosted by a Shore conference school must come through the Arbiter. This includes any Invitational, Sub-varsity and Novice meets.
  - a. Any official who officiates a meet, hosted by or run at a Shore Conference high school, that has not been assigned by the Arbiter will no longer be considered to be a (“member in good standing”). The penalty for this will be: not to be assigned any meets the following school year.
  - b. Any official not in the position of an assignor, who makes meet assignments for any HS meet hosted by or run at a Shore Conference high school, will no longer be considered to be a (“member in good standing”). The penalty for this will be: not to be assigned any meets the following school year.
  - c. A member’s status will **not** be affected in emergency replacement situations. Each situation will be handled individually.

The above statements do NOT pertain to any assignments to elementary or non NJSIAA affiliated high school meets.

4. Meet Directors/Organizers will be given the opportunity to submit their preference list of officials to the Chapter Assignor prior to the Invitational Meet. The Assignor will have the latitude to make adjustments and fill vacated positions.
