4. Ray McCusker informed everyone of the new state rule change regarding Cross Country entrants. There can be unlimited entrants in meets of less than 4 teams and they all must be considered scorers (no non-scorer designations). In meets of over 5 teams, the rule of 7 entrants will still apply. He also reminded us that the fee for Cross Country will be \$50 for one race and \$60 for two races.
5. Tonight's workshop was Cross Country scoring. Ray McCusker handed out sheets for scoring sample meets. Since the Starter is the Referee, knowledge of scoring is imperative.
